Calling of Grace

Grace (Gk. *charis*) is unwarranted goodwill, undeserved kindness, and unmerited favour. Calling (Gk. *klēsis*) is the state of having been summoned, named or called (Gk. *kaleō*) to someone or something. Grace and calling are gifts of God, unwarranted, unmerited and undeserved on our part (Eph 2:8). Grace and calling came in the form of a person, Jesus Christ, who called us to God.

Covenant EFC is a church of grace and calling. Covenant EFC heard God's particular calling over 25 years ago, *"The smallest one will become a clan, and the least one a mighty nation. I, the LORD, will hasten it in its time."* (Isa 60:22, NASB). It was a call to trust in God's grace and faithfulness, to build a church of authentic disciples who choose to grow as intentional disciplemakers. God calls each of us to His grace, changes us into *A Certain Kind*, and sends us on a mission to win our world for Christ.

God reminded us of His calling of Isa 60:22 as we sought Him

these past two years before embarking on this fresh venture of grace and faith of planting Covenant EFC's third worship centre in Singapore's East. This is a calling of grace; it is completely undeserved favour. It is a calling of faith; God has spoken; it is a pilgrimage of trusting God to do His work through us.

Be it the Bukit Panjang Centre journey of 1996-2000; the Woodlands Centre journey of 2005-2008; or the ACKCentre journey of 2012-2014—these are all not merely ventures of faith, but ventures of grace. God need *not* call Covenant EFC, but He did. Covenant EFC is not the best nor the biggest church, but God called us.

Covenant East Centre, launching on 6 Nov, 2016, is first a calling of grace before it is a venture of faith. Are you residing in the East or near the East, or have a burden for the East? We call you to partner with us in this grace-calling faith-venture of pioneering Covenant East Centre, because God has called Covenant EFC!

Prepare the Way for Jesus

Scripture: **LUKE 2:36-38** // Sermon: **SHARON FONG**

Introduction

In the words of Nancy Campbell, "God puts within every female an innate desire and anointing to nurture." We are called to nurture someone and influence our next generation.

Three Principles to Prepare the Way for Jesus

A. Surrendering to God's Will

1. Anna did not become a widow at old age but becomes one shortly after seven years of marriage.
2. Anna carries the status of a widow for at least 60 years.
3. Anna carries not only the status of widowhood but along with it are pain, shame, and loneliness.
4. Beneath our title, stature, status, or accolades, are we struggling with any pain, shame, and loneliness?
5. God does not just want us to get married and bear children. God wants us to get serious with Jesus and bear witness for Him.

B. Staying in God's Presence

1. Anna did not just stay in the temple because she was homeless.
2. Anna constantly stays in the temple, praying and fasting, day and night.
3. Through praying and fasting, Anna is preparing herself to meet God.
4. What are you preparing in life?
5. Are we busy preparing our children to meet the world and forgetting that we need to prepare them to meet God?
6. Are we hungering after God's presence? Our children's spiritual hunger to meet God is often not only taught by us but most importantly inspired and caught from us.

C. Speaking of God's Redemption

1. What are we speaking to our children today? Are they words of faith, hope, and redemption?
2. We must be watchful and ensure that our words do not steal or destroy.
3. Otherwise, whatever we build with one hand may be destroyed quickly by the other hand.

Conclusion

When our broken lives are in the hands of God, our latter years can be more glorious than the former ones.
