Disciple Now for the Next Generation of Leaders!

he place is not sacred, but the posture and process of seeking the Lord each year for His direction for Covenant EFC is. The annual pilgrimage of the Senior Pastor's Office (SPO) to Kota Kinabalu back in July 2016 was such. Today begins the first Heartbeat article about the Five Faith Exploits that the Lord confirmed for 2028, the year when Covenant EFC turns 50. Pray, support, and co-labour with us as we do what the Lord has led us to.

Surely one of the strategic task of being an Authentic Discipleship and Intentional Disciplemaking Church of A Certain Kind must be to disciple now the next generation of leaders for the Church of God. Yet, leaders of A Certain Kind do not just grow on any tree! Instead they are discipled through the pilgrimage of life and ministry, and forged through moments of success and crucibles of failures and pain.

The Barna Group in their longitudinal research concluded that churches' dropout problem is, at its core, a disciplemaking problem. David Kinnaman says in his book *You Lost Me*: "The church is not adequately preparing the next generation to follow Christ faithfully in a

rapidly changing culture." This same principle applies to church leadership. "Entrust these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also," Paul exhorts in 2 Timothy 2:2-6. Christ's gospel and teachings are to be responsibly handed over to faithful men (v.2), who are ready (v.3), resolute (v.4), responsible (v.5), and resilient (v.6) to pass it further on to other faithful men. These are the *A Certain Kind* which are grown, not just plucked off any tree!

It has taken over 20 years to grow and groom the current set of SPO in the grace and provision of the Lord. The question is not merely who the next generation leaders are, but what kind — who and what kind of Deacons, Ministry Staff, Elders, Pastors, SPO and Senior Pastor must Covenant EFC entrust its mandate of authentic discipleship and intentional disciplemaking of *A Certain Kind* to?

It takes *A Certain Kind* of leaders to grow and groom *A Certain Kind* of next generation leaders. Let's **disciple now** so that the Next Generation of *A Certain Kind* of Leaders of faithful men may be raised for Covenant EFC!

LAST WEEK'S SERMON SUMMARY

Rebuilding the Foundation

SCRIPTURE: OVERVIEW OF EZRA AND HAGGAL - SERMON: REV TONY YEO

Introduction

- Three Spiritual Burdens for 2017: Foundation in God, Faith in God and Fruitfulness for God Illustration: Ravi Zacharias on the Wexner Centre for Arts — we can be careless with the infra-structure of a building but not the foundation.
- 2. Why the post-exilic book Ezra and prophetic book Haggai? Haggai is mentioned in Ezra 5:1. Context for Ezra: God has a covenant relationship with His people (Exo 24:4-8). He renewed his covenant with the second generation through blessings and curses (Deut 28:49, 64) resulting in Israel (2 Kin 17:5-6) and Judah (2 Kin 25:8-11)being exiled. God's final Word is "this whole land shall become a ruin...for seventy years" (Jer 25:11).
- 3. Three Things We Must Do in Rebuilding Our Foundation:

A. We Must Return to the Worship of God (Ezra 1–6)

- 1. Ezra 1:1-2 "... the Lord stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia..." God moved, inspired, woke up the heart of a foreign king, to build a temple for God in Jerusalem!
- 2. Why rebuild the temple after the return from exile? Exodus 25:22 "There I will meet with you... I will speak with you..." Focus: So that God can meet with us. Return to the worship of God. Meet Him daily.
- 3. Application: How to prepare to meet God for Sunday worship? Orientate your heart on Saturday night, go to bed early, get up early enough on Sunday, begin seeking God as soon as you enter.

B. We Must Realign to the <u>Way</u> of God (Haggai 1–2)

- 1. Two interesting features in the book of Haggai: second shortest book in the Old Testament and most datable book in the Bible (five specific dates over three and a half months).
- 2. The Jews suffered mission drift for 15 years. They started well but went on cruising and surviving mode.
- 3. "Consider your ways ..." (Hag 1:5,7) re-evaluate the purpose of your life and re-examine the priorities of your life. Move from mission drift to realigning the mission to God's way.
- 4. Application: Covenant App for reaching the lost to keep us walking in God's way

C. We Must Restore the **Word** of God (Ezra 7-10)

- 1. The temple of God was finally rebuilt (Ezr 6:15).
- 2. After about 60 years, God sent another spiritual leader, Ezra, back to Jerusalem. Why? Because the people who returned, including the priests and Levites intermarried with the locals (Ezr 9:1-2).
- 3. Point: The people knew God's Law but did not live it out. Obey and act upon HisWord!
- 4. Application: Are there areas where we know the Word and yet are not obeying it?

Conclusion

Illustration: The fall of the 270-year-old Tembusu tree last 11 Feb 2017. May Covenant EFC not appear ok and respectable on the outside only to fall because of its foundations. Rebuild the foundation of our lives. Come built an altar unto His Name!
