Facilitating the Five Faith Exploits

Over the past weeks, the Senior Pastor's Office (SPO) wrote about the broad strokes of the *Five Faith Exploits*. These are the exploits which God graciously placed in our hearts as we sought His guidance on how to flesh out *Vision 2028* in last year's SPO Listening Retreat.

However, the faith exploits may become just nice words, concepts and diagrams on paper that amount to nothing, unless we arise in faith to help facilitate and support them. We read in Ezra 1 that when God stirred the spirits of the Jews to return to Jerusalem and rebuild the temple, they responded in faith and obedience to make the arduous journey away from the comfort and familiarity of Babylon to the devastated ruins of Jerusalem. Similarly, Covenant EFC must also respond to the God-given trumpet call of *Vision 2028* and the *Five Faith Exploits*.

We need to step up to serve at the point of our calling and gifting (1 Pet 4:10). There will be many opportunities to serve, so do look out for our church-wide *Step-Up Sundays*, ministry recruitment announcements, and our church bulletin and website.

Mobilisation is not just about opportunities to serve. Over the past two years, our *Covenant Mobilisation* team has been defining a process by which we hope to better help Covenanters successfully find their place of service in the church, ensure they are equipped to serve well and that they are managed and cared for as they serve.

We also need wisdom from God for appropriate organisational structures, processes, competencies, infrastructure, facilities and technology. The Covenant EFC app, for instance, is one such initiative. Through the app, we are now able to provide information, resources and social media engagements to facilitate daily discipleship, breaking down traditional barriers of time and geography. Recently, a Board committee was set up pooling together leaders and property-related expertise which will be crucial for addressing the needs of our current and future worship centres.

Exciting days lie ahead as we ask the Lord to work out the *Five Faith Exploits* through us. May we step forward in faith to put our hands to the plough, while trusting Him to fully provide all that we need.

SCRIPTURE: EZRA 3:1-6 ■ SERMON: REV EDMUND CHAN

Introduction

1. A brief overview of Israel's history – From Abram to the Exile
2. Ezra chapter 3 is all about a fresh start with God!
3. Start Afresh – Conversion, Restoration and Re-Dedication

Three Vital Principles as seen in Ezra 3:1-6

A. STARTING AFRESH WITH A DEEP SENSE OF CALLING

“...*the people gathered as one man to Jerusalem*” (v.1)

1. Where and what we gather for is important!
2. The purpose of unity is the unity of PURPOSE
3. Illustration. Church Unity Seminar postponed – Disunited Board!
4. Satan's Scheme: Division and Disunity
5. Application. Unite with a deep sense of CALLING

B. STARTING AFRESH WITH A BOLD SENSE OF FAITH

“...*fear was on them...*” (v.3)

1. Our call to obey God must trump over our fears.
2. Their answer lies not in a Army but upon an Altar.
3. Notice HOW they built the Altar: “as it is written” (v.2)
4. Notice WHEN they built the Altar: “the seventh month” (v.1)
 - a. Rosh Hashannah – New Year! A Fresh Start!
 - b. Tishri (festive month) – 10th day of Tishri is Yom Kippur!
 - c. Feast of Tabernacles – The Deliverance and Provision of God!
5. Application. Do Not Fear – God will Deliver and Provide!

C. STARTING AFRESH WITH A CLEAR SENSE OF PRIORITY

“... *the foundation of the temple of the LORD was not yet laid...*” (v.6)

1. A rebuke? No. An indicative statement of Priority!
2. “First day” (v.6) – First things first!
3. Principle. Worship precedes Work (not ‘substitutes work’)
4. Focus. Getting Right With God!! The Altar
5. The sacrifices on the Altar points us to JESUS and the Cross.
6. It's not repentance that makes the cross possible (vice versa!)
7. G.K. Chesterton: “The Cross cannot be defeated. For it is defeat.”

Conclusion. A Fresh Start! Back to the CROSS!!
