Any statement about the future is a statement of faith. Yes? The question then is: Is that statement of God, and is that faith in God?

Any statement about the future that God makes is a matter of fact to Him, but a matter of faith for us. This is demonstrated throughout biblical history. Acts 1:8 is a statement of fact to God, but required unprecedented pioneering faith for the early disciples! The rest is history. Today, we are living in the unfolding reality of Acts 1:8!

In 1978, a Gospel-centred, forward-looking and growth-oriented pioneering spirit gave birth to Covenant EFC when 17 members stepped out to plant a church in a humble HDB 5 room flat. Later in 1987, Isaiah 60:22

The smallest one will become a clan, and the least one a mighty nation. I, the LORD, will hasten it in its time.

was a faith promise given to Covenant EFC through then Senior Pastor Edmund Chan that we will be a thousand strong. To a small congregation of just over a hundred without a permanent home, this was highly implausible. But to God, it was really a matter of fact which came to pass in year 2000 at our first worship service in Bukit Panjang Centre! The rest is history. Today, we are living in the unfolding reality of Isaiah 60:22!

This is what Covenant EFC's intentional discipling church (IDMC) mission statement —

authentic discipleship and intentional discipling so as to reproduce disciples of A Certain Kind and to multiply them to win the world for Christ!

is all about: To continue the Lord's mission; to continue the 17 pioneers' missionary spirit; to continue Isaiah 60:22 movement. In 2003, the Church Board inked this ethos in its Long-Term Planning paper. In 2008, Woodlands Centre came into being. Bukit Panjang Centre, Woodlands Centre and ACKCentre are Spirit-led and sacrificial faith ventures by over 2,000 Covenanters without any bank loan or debt in the midst of three Asian and global financial crises! This same boldness resulted in Covenant East Centre in 2016. Lord willing, we will plant a Covenant West Centre in 2021.

1978 was a pushback against a maintenance mindset. It led to a growing IDMC with multiple-centres over the last 40 years. We believe that God would want Covenant EFC to be a movement and not a monument; — to spur an IDMC movement of like-minded churches in Singapore and Beyond!

What a privilege to partner with God in a Gospel-Centred, Forward-Looking and Growth-Oriented pioneering faith venture that only God can accomplish through His Church. This is Vision 2028 & Beyond – to arrive at our Golden Jubilee celebration having spurred a Global IDMC movement by being a thriving Local IDMC movement!

Last Week's Sermon Summary

Chosen Instruments

SCRIPTURE: ACTS 9:1-15 • SERMON: REV COLIN SMITH

Paul was a chosen instrument used in the hands of God for the advance of the Gospel (v.15). God's work gets done through His people. How can we be the kind of people God will use to advance His purpose in the world?

The people God uses are compelled by the glory of Christ. Saul of Tarsus saw the risen Lord and heard His voice (vv.3, 4). One day every person will see the glory of the Lord. A believer is a person who has been gripped by the glory of Christ now. We have seen the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ (2 Cor 4:6).

The people God uses are humbled by the mercy of Christ. Saul saw himself as a righteous man, but when He was confronted by Christ, he knew that he was a sinner and that he had sinned against the sovereign Lord of the universe (vv.4, 5). Those who came to know Jesus have a whole new view of themselves. Pride and swagger cannot remain in the hearts of those who know that they hang on to the mercy of God.

The people God uses are submitted to the Lordship of Christ. Saul was told what he must do (v.6). Submission to Christ is not a burden but a relief. Saul had been kicking against the goads (Acts 26:14). As long as you resist the Lordship of Christ you are wounding yourself and relief will only come by submitting yourself entirely to Him.

Finally, the people God uses are engaged in the mission of Christ. Paul proclaimed Jesus in the synagogues, saying that He is the Son of God (Acts 9:19-20). This was the pattern of apostolic ministry. They did not set out to change the world. They set out to proclaim Christ who changed them, and through their witness to Jesus, lives were transformed, churches were planted and that changed the world.

God's work gets done by people who are compelled by the glory of Christ, humbled by the mercy of Christ, submitted to the Lordship of Christ, and engaged in the mission of Christ. Are you ready to offer yourself as a chosen instrument in the Redeemer's hand?
