ot long ago, I patronised the English section of a bookstore in an Asian city. The bookstore is part of a wellknown international chain. Not knowing that bookstores in the chain were independent of each other, I asked the cashier whether I could use the membership card which I obtained in Singapore. After politely explaining that I could not and that a separate card was needed for that city, the cashier then surprised me by thanking me for patronising the store in Singapore! "Wow," I thought. Even though the stores were unrelated, she had an affinity and cared for the Singapore store because they shared the same brand name.

We in Covenant EFC share the same name too, as "child of God" and "Covenanter". Even more, therefore, we should care for one another. B. The Word of God Which Holds on to Us and Convicts Us (vv.13-21, 30-35)

"But Paul and Barnabas remained in Antioch, teaching and preaching the word of the Lord." (v. 35)

Last Week's Sermon Summary

Staying True Scripture: acts 14:1-28 • Sermon: PS ann Chan

Introduction

In our 39 years in Covenant EFC, Ps Ed and I have been actively discipling — because intentional disciplemaking is in our spiritual DNA. Over the years, we have seen many Christians needing to learn to stay true to God through the passage of time.

Acts 14:1-28 gives us three reminders on Staying True to our Lord:

A. Staying True Is About the Cross, Not Our Convenience (vv.1-7, 19-22)

- 1. Context: Acts 13 began Paul's first missionary journey from Antioch to Cyprus (through Seleucia, Salamis and Paphos) arriving in Perga and Pisidian Antioch. In Acts 14, he arrived in Iconium, then Lystra and Derbe.
- 2. Faithful Preaching of the Cross: Wherever Paul and Barnabas went, they never let the "many persecutions" thwart their purpose (v.22).
- 3. Transformed Lives begets Transformed Ministry: The key to staying true is a transformed life.

B. Staying True Is About the Glory of God, Not Our Gifting (vv.8-18)

- 1. God blessed the work and glory belongs to God alone: Paul acknowledged that God alone deserves the glory. He detest all forms of pride (cf. Prov 8:13). We need to consciously police our competitive spirit, boasting, sense of importance, belittling other leaders and especially claiming glory that only belongs to God.
- 2. Propagate an Honour Culture: First, we are to honour God. Second, we are to honour our spiritual leaders because they are the ones who have watched over our souls and brought us up spiritually at some point in our lives. Matthew 10:24 reminds us that "a disciple is not above his teacher ..."

C. Staying True Is About the Grace of God, Not Our Works (vv.23-28).

- 1. Paul and Barnabas responded to God's grace and consecrated their lives and ministry to God (v.26).
- 2. 2 Corinthians 9:8 "God is able to make all grace abound ... so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work ..."

Conclusion

Staying True is about focusing on the Cross, **not** robbing God of His Glory, and being empowered daily by His grace!
