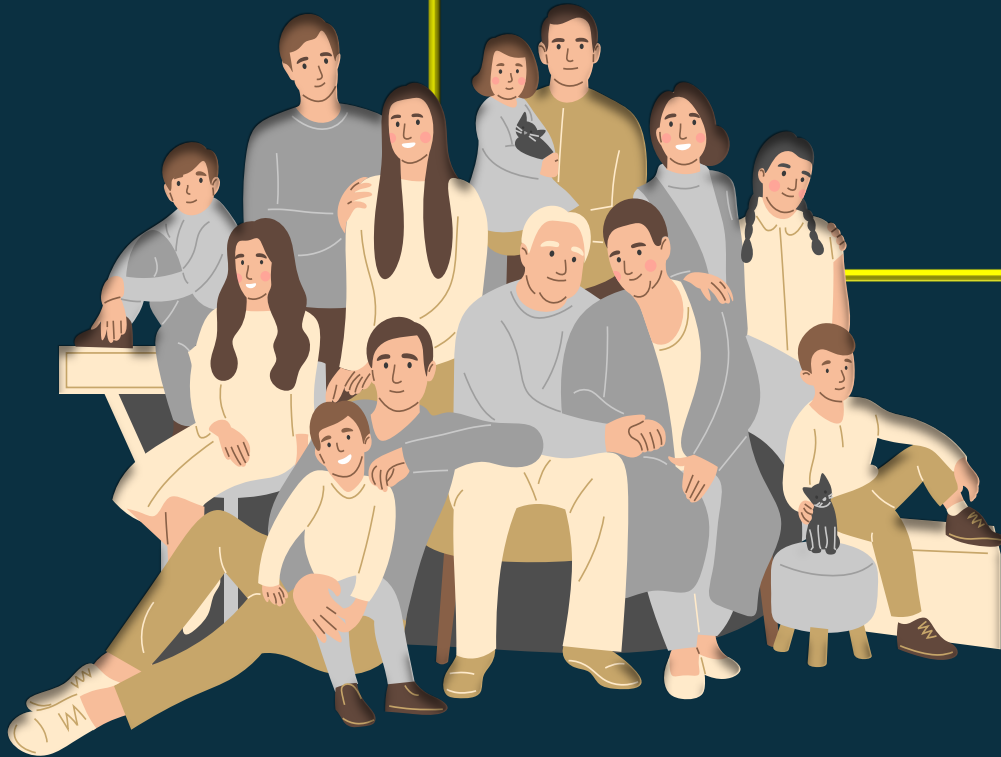

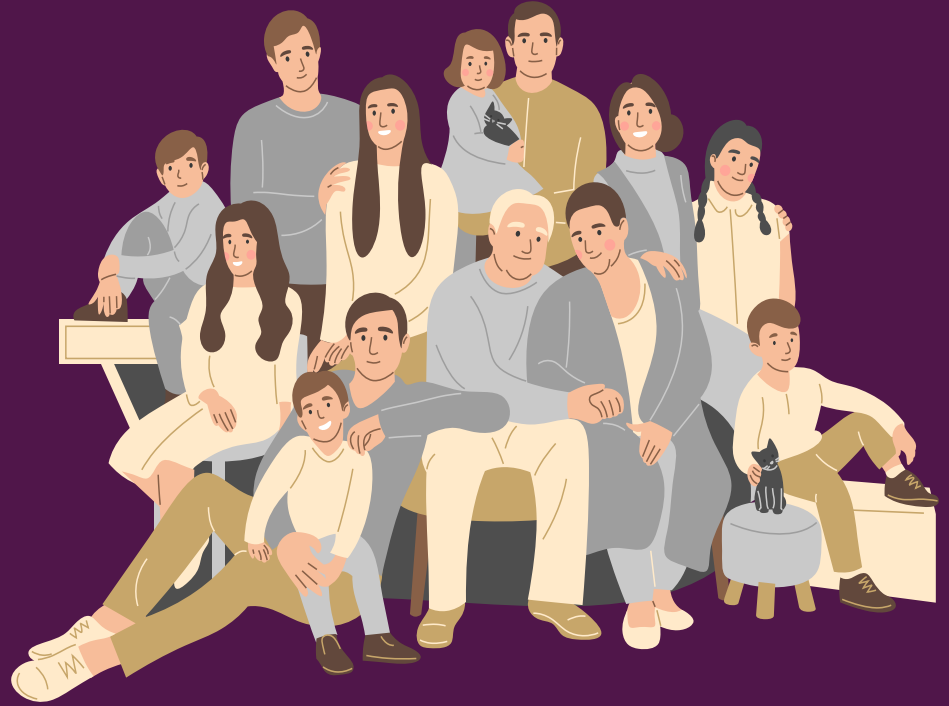

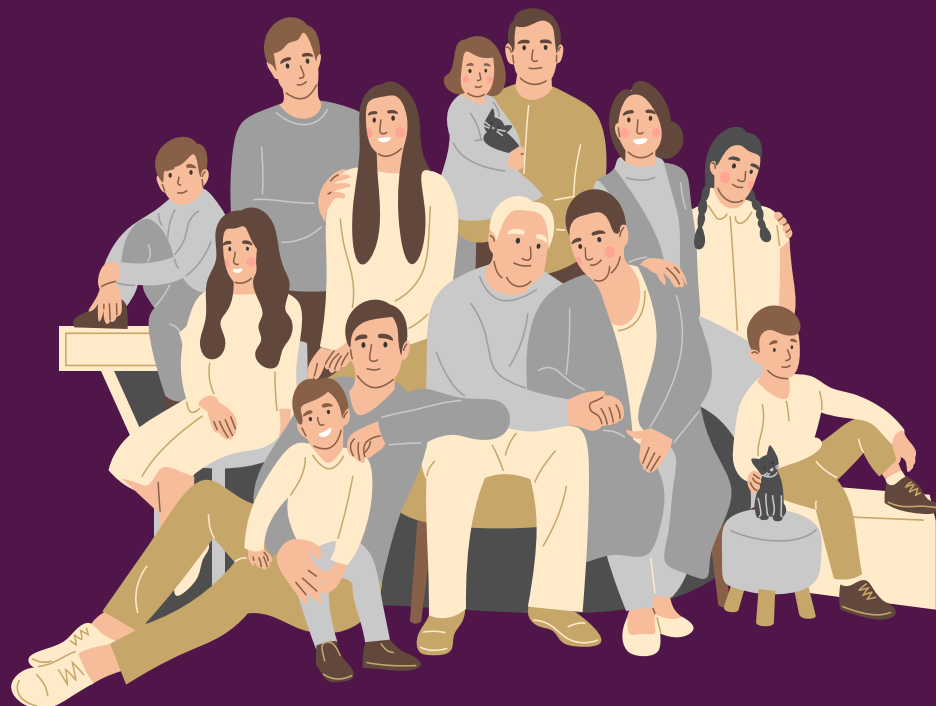

**1 Words of Affirmation**  
For some people, verbal expressions of love fills their emotional tank.

**2 Acts of Service**  
People in this group feel loved when their partner demonstrates a willingness to make their lives easier.

**3 Receiving Gifts**  
This love language focuses on the thought and effort put into selecting a gift.

**5 Physical Touch**  
Physical touch or gestures like hugs, kisses, holding hands, cuddling, and physical intimacy is how some people feel loved.

**4 Quality Time**  
People in this group value undistracted quality time with loved ones.

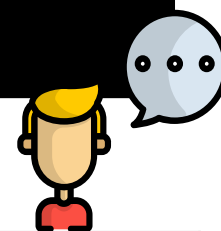

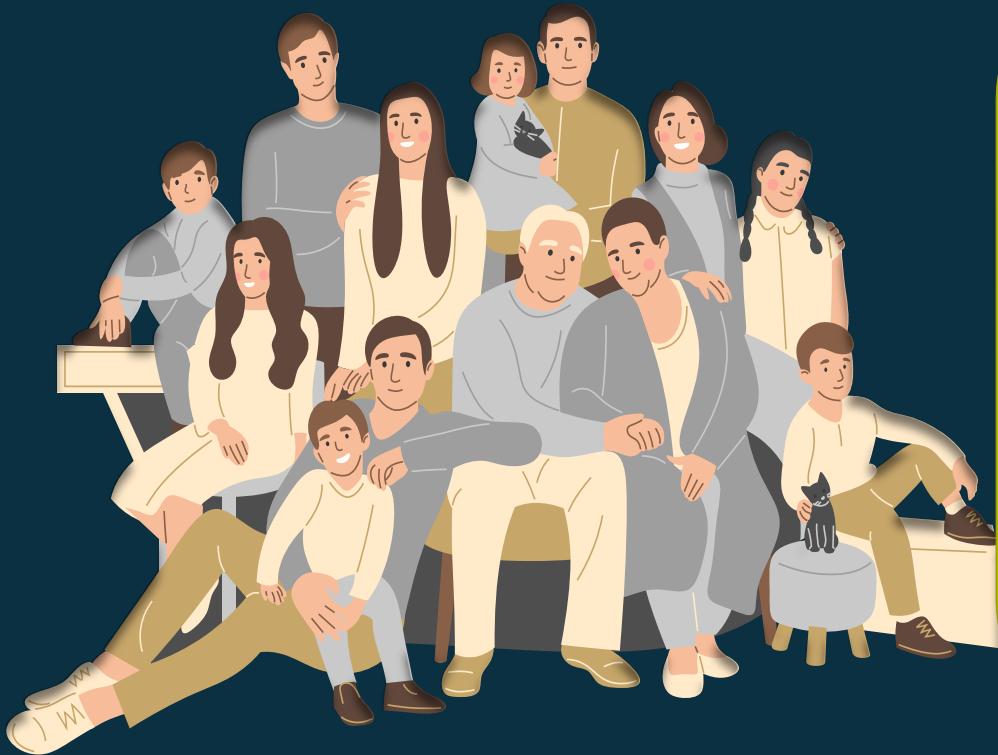

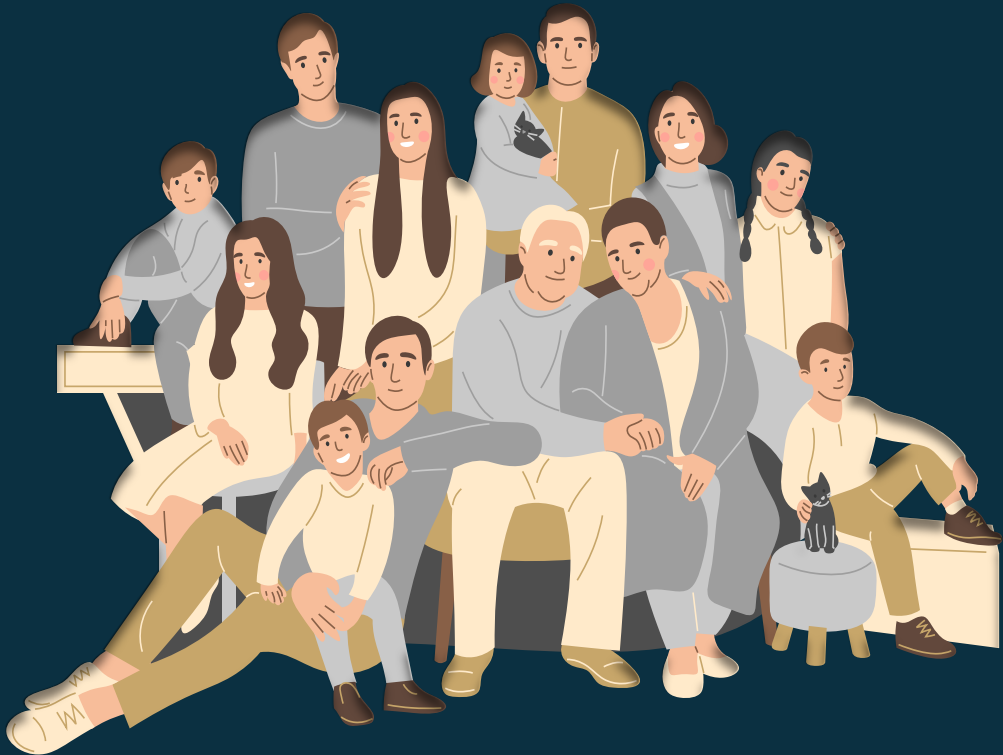


### Application

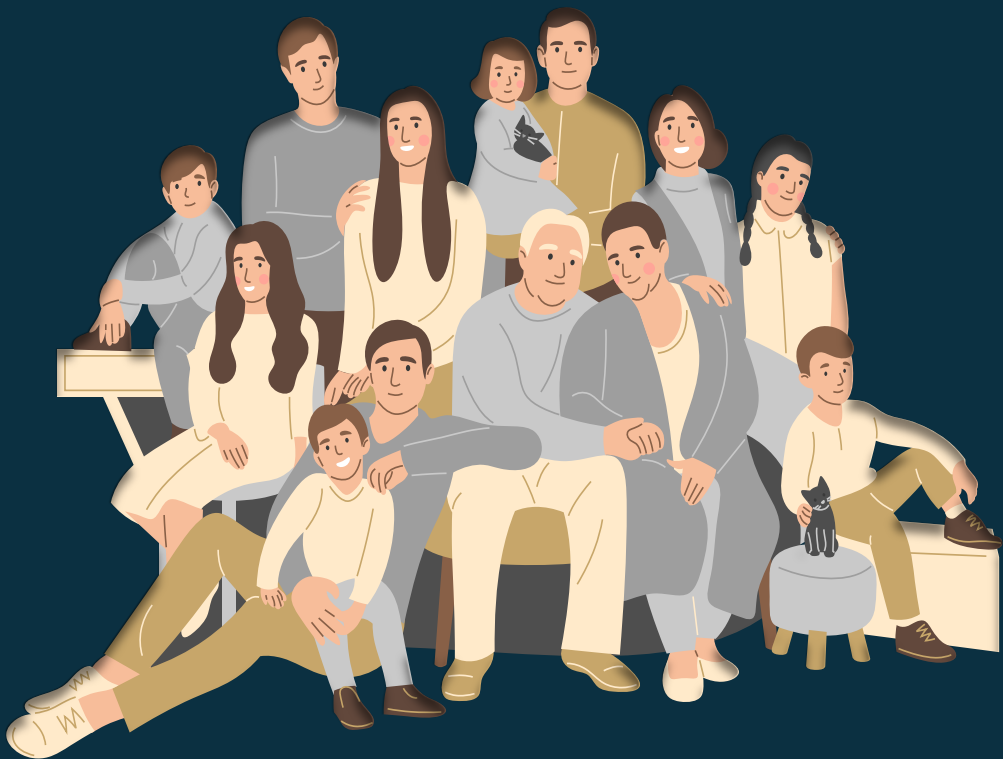
- Choose **one or more person** from your sharing group and **show love** to them using their love language before the end of camp.
